It is vital that those working within the Dental Practice understand how important it is to always ensure the safety and security of anyone within their care, or who they come into contact with as part of their role, in line with CQC standards.

The purpose of this course is to clarify the roles and responsibilities of General Dental Practitioners and the dental team in promoting the safety and well-being of children, young people and vulnerable adults. This guidance also supports dental practitioners in meeting the Government Standards for Health Services & General Dental Council standards.

You will be provided with the knowledge required to recognise the signs of abuse and respond appropriately to suspected or alleged abuse. In addition, you will also have an increased understanding of the most appropriate ways to reduce the likelihood of abuse as well as recognise and report unsafe practices.

Aim:

To help dental care professionals look at the Mental Capacity Act, how it will affect them and help them develop best practice.

2. Be able to recognise the national and local context of safeguarding and protection from abuse
